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






China Europe trains Development



China Europe trains per year (both directions)



- > Transported goods:
 - Consumer and luxury goods
 - Finished goods of premium German carmakers
 - Spare parts for automobile as well as mechanical and plant engineering industry
- Further substantial growth expected over upcoming years
- Growing focus on quality of the product: Transport time, reliability, capacity utilization

China Europe trains Duisburg with important role







- Every week, 35-40 trains run between Duisburg and a dozen destinations in China
- Approximately 30% of China Europe trains pass through the Port of Duisburg
- In financial year 2018, approximately 130,000 TEU were transported on these trains through the Port of Duisburg
